In Response to Nevada Stay at Home 2.0

On Tuesday, November 10, Governor Sisolak implemented Stay at Home 2.0. This is a request to Nevadans for the next two weeks to limit non-essential activities to slow the spread of COVID-19 within our community.

At this time, The Lakes Lutheran Church remains open for the groups and churches that use our facility.

We strongly encourage each group to follow their submitted health and safety plan which includes keeping at least 6 feet apart (social distancing), wearing face coverings at all times within the building, cleaning and disinfecting high touch surfaces before and after meetings, as well as not lingering after meetings.

When you meet in the building please keep an exterior door open to allow for fresh air flow.

If your group is in a position to meet virtually or suspend meetings for the next two weeks, please consider making this temporary change.
