

Updated Masking Guidance – July 21, 2021

To slow the spread of COVID-19 in our community, the Southern Nevada Health District has recommended the wearing of masks by all persons regardless of vaccinated status and as of July 21, 2021, Clark County is requiring that masks be worn by all employees in indoor public spaces.

With this new guidance, the current masking policy of The Lakes Lutheran Church and their guests is as follows:

*The wearing of face coverings by those who are fully vaccinated (that is two weeks after receiving your final dose) is optional, **but encouraged**, while meeting inside The Lakes Lutheran Church. Physical distancing requirements of at least 3 feet between persons of different households and varying, unknown, vaccinated status should continue to be followed while meeting. Those persons who are not vaccinated continue to be required to wear a face covering both nose and mouth while meeting inside the building. Employees of The Lakes Lutheran Church will wear masks while serving in public spaces.*

Consistent with the ethic of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, our governing church body, The Lakes Lutheran Church encourages all persons to be vaccinated, if they are able to be vaccinated. In all things, it is the hope of The Lakes Lutheran Church that all will continue to exercise caution and practice love for our neighbors and our Las Vegas community.
